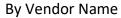

Subject: Prequalify Contractors for GAC Treatment Plant

Objective: Prequalify contractors for the granular activated carbon (GAC) treatment plant to be built at the Conejo Wellfield.

Action Required: Approve James C. Cushman, Pacific Hydrotech, and W.M. Lyles Co., Inc. as prequalified contractors for the construction of the GAC treatment plant at the Conejo Wellfield.

Discussion: At the June 24, 2021 Board meeting, the Board of Directors authorized staff to prequalify contractors for construction of the GAC treatment plant at the Conejo Wellfield. Prequalifying is intended to vet the pool of potential bidders on the construction project and reduce the amount of time between finalizing design and awarding the construction contract.

On June 28, 2021 the District released and Application for Prequalification, advertising in the Ventura County *Star* and through Quest CDN, a digital project advertisement service. Three firms submitted application packets: W.M. Lyles Co., Pacific Hydrotech, and James C. Cushman, Inc.

All three are reputable firms in good standing in the community. Camrosa has had positive experiences with all three on various projects over the last 25 years. All three fulfilled the requirements of the application package and, after review by staff and MKN, are considered qualified to undertake the project.

This was not a bidding process. No cost estimates or projections were included. No costs are associated with the Board's approval of these contractors as prequalified.

Pending approval of these contractors by the Board, staff will issue a public notice of accepted contractors. The GAC treatment plant construction project will not be advertised; only the approved prequalified contractors will be eligible to bid. This is expected to save approximately one month of bidding time.

Prequalification is no guarantee that any bid will be selected or even accepted; contractors must still meet the requirements of the bid documents and will be held to the same review process and scoring criteria as during any other bid process. Staff will return to the Board to award a construction contract once the bid process is complete (anticipated by November 2021).
