The contract documents for the Lynnwood Well Iron and Manganese Treatment System Procurement are modified as follows:

Instructions to Proposers Modifications:

On Page 00 21 14 - 6

It is optional for Proposers to respond to Sections **13.3.2.3**, **13.3.2.4**, **13.3.2.5**, **13.3.2.6**, and **13.3.2.7**. A life cycle cost analysis is no longer required for this proposal. Sections **13.3.2.1** and **13.3.2.2** are still required.

Answers to Contractor questions:

1) How much input does the Water District have and how much input does the Engineer have in reviewing the proposals?

Answer – The Engineer will be providing a technical review of the proposals for the Water District as to whether the proposals meet the technical specifications. The Engineer will provide the District the results of the technical review including a list of the exceptions for each proposal received. The Engineer will also score the proposals according to the RFQ instructions but will not provide a recommendation to the District. District staff will also review and score the proposals. District staff will then review all scores and the technical review from the Engineer. District staff will then choose what equipment provider to select.
